EVERYONE MAKES THE BAND!!! Auditions will be for band placement **for the entire school year!** It is important that you be as prepared as possible for this audition. This audition will determine your band placement. Regardless of how good/bad your audition is, you will be welcomed to the Tiger Band!

- You will have 4 minutes to play as much of the audition music as possible
- Each Theme/Variation is worth ten points. Your score per theme/variation will be based on your tone production/ speed (tempo)/ and most importantly ACCURACY.
- Those who play each segment with a steady tempo and the most accurately will score the highest.
- You do not need to go fast!!!! You do need to sound good and play accurately
- Audition results will be posted sometime during the Summer.
- The directors will communicate with the school counselors to ensure you get in the appropriate band period.
- If you have any questions, please feel free to email the directors.

Students need to sign up for an audition time. Please make sure you are warmed up and ready to audition BEFORE your assigned time. (your audition is only 4 minutes long)
